MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

- 1. Both parties agree to promote National Academic Cooperation through the following activities:
  - ❖ Innovation in education pertaining to Business Administration.
  - Training and Placement.
  - ❖ Joint workshops, Seminars and Conference
  - ❖ Joint collaboration in preparation of study materials related to Training and **Development for Students.**
  - Continuous evaluation process to monitor the progress of students.
  - Periodic lectures by faculty on an honorary basis to enrich the knowledge base of the students.
- This memorandum shall be applicable to educational and training organizations attached to each party.

- 3. This memorandum constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and all prior discussions, agreements and undertakings, whether verbal or in writing is merged in this agreement.
- 4. This memorandum shall become effective as of the date of signature of both parties. The agreement may be amended by the written consent of the parties.
- 5. This memorandum is not considered to be a contract creating legal relationships between the parties. Rather it is designed to facilitate and develop a genuine and mutually beneficial exchange process.
- 6. This memorandum shall be reviewed every three years to evaluate the progress and quality of the mutual Co-operation. The agreement may be extended for additional three year periods upon the written consent of both parties. If the agreement is not renewed by mutual consent, the agreement will conclude at the end of the specified time period or after activities in progress have concluded.
- 7. This memorandum may be terminated by either party with a minimum of 120 days written notice Activities in progress at the time of termination of this agreement shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.
- 8. Both institutions subscribe to a policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, colour, gender, age, height, weight, marital or familial status, ethnicity religion, nationality or disability.

# THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING DATED AT 19<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2019

Between

Dr.Ambedkar Govt Arts College represented by Dr.A.Geetha, Principal (by designation) having her office at Vyasarpadi, Chennai-39, Tamilnadu, hereinafter called the First party

And

The Indian Spectro Physics Association (ISPA), Chennai, India represented by Dr.S. Gunasekaran, Founder President of the Association (ISPA) having his office at Pachaiyappa's college, Chennai hereinafter called the Second party.

do hereby agree to the following:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Dr.Ambedkar Govt Arts College(Autonomous) Vyasarpadi, Chennai- 600 039. Tamilnadu, and Indian Spectro Physics Association (ISPA) Sets forth the agreement of the parties with respect to mutually benefit initiative to strength the training system and facilitate knowledge partnership for Academic and Research Programmes for sustained Researchers.

### 1. Objective and role of partnership

- 1.1 Dr.Ambedkar Govt Arts College(Autonomous) Vyasarpadi, Chennai- 600 039.

  Tamilnadu, and Indian Spectro Physics Association partnership is constituted in mutual consultation with each other and based on the overwhelming positive response for academic and Research collaboration for mutual benefit of both the parties of the partnership concerned.
- 1.2 The Primary Objective of the partnership is to provide a platform for Researchers to interact with the academia for knowledge sharing and for catalyzing joint initiatives to launch development programmes for the benefit of Researchers. Such knowledge sharing is not merely in terms of the number of human resources required for the types training and skill sets, but is also intended to be much deeper with long-term strategic goals and advantages for both the parties. This partnership will also cater to the needs of educational, research and consultancy programmes in the area of Science and Technology.
- 1.3 The activities would involve:
  - (i) Conducting Science Awareness Programmes
  - (ii) Conducting PG Students Technical Seminars
  - (iii) Conducting Workshop for College and University Teachers
  - (iv) Organizing Conferences on Applied Sciences
- 1.4 Since the primary objective of the partnership is to become a platform to facilitate Knowledge sharing, the methods of functioning will be as follows:-
  - (i) Help the process for Faculty Development in both organizations by taking up Joint Research and Consultancy Projects
  - (ii) Jointly Identify Expert Resource Persons

# 2. Member of the partnership committee

2.1 The partnership committee will comprise representatives from Dr.Ambedkar Govt Arts College(Autonomous) Vyasarpadi, Chennai- 600 039. Tamilnadu, and representatives of the ISPA with a term of one year with subsequent renewals and modifications for a further period of one year, subject to renewal

Chairperson - Dr.A.Geetha, Principal, Dr.Ambedkar Govt. Arts, College, Chennai - 39, Tamilnadu.

Co- Chairperson - Dr. S. Gunasekaran, Founder President, ISPA.

And

Two Members drawn from Dr.Ambedkar Govt Arts College (Autonomous)

Vyasarpadi, Chennai- 600 039 and ISPA

- 2.2 The partnership Committee would meet once every quarter to take stock of the progress and give directions to the various clauses for implementation.
- Dr.Ambedkar Govt. Arts, College, and ISPA would provide dedicated staff to work very closely to achieve the goals of the partnership. The Members of ISPA and Dr.Ambedkar Govt. Arts, College, will be the coordinators for the Partnership Committee.
- 2.4 The Agreement shall commence on 19 7-2019 and shall continue in force until terminated by mutual consent after prior written notice by either party to the other party. The termination will be subject to compliance to the completion of all commitments made. Notwithstanding any such termination, both parties shall ensure that all activities in progress are completed successfully.
- 2.5 This MoU will be valid for a period of three years from the date of signing of this MoU. After the expiry of this period, the MoU may be extended for further three years based on mutual Interest.
