The Certificate Course on Logistics and Planning Management is conducted by the Times Professional Learning under the State Government initiative, NAAN MUDHALVAN in collaboration with Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation and Directorate of Collegiate Education from 21/7/2022 and is expected to complete on 16/9/2022.

The Final year students were selected based on their performance of a Screening test. The first Online Screening test, opened to students of Arts, Commerce and Management streams, was conducted on June 6, 2022 at 12.30pm at RUSA Auditorium with 79 students attending the entrance test after Google Form registration. The second phase of Screening test was open to Science Streams other than Computer Science and PG was conducted on July 1, 2022 at 10 am at RUSA Auditorium. This was followed by a series of tests to add more students.



A total of 224 students registered in different phases of which 136 students were selected. Since the inception of the course, an average of 68 students attended on a daily basis as many went to take up jobs after their final semester examinations.

The Inauguration of the Course was held virtually on July 12, 2022 with TNSDC officials, Members of Times Pro, Experts from Industry. After the Inauguration, Mr. L. Vijayakumar, Regional Head, Times Pro addressed the students. Our Principal Dr. R Sumathi presided the event and motivated the participants. Dr. Bharathidasan, College Coordinator of NAAN MUDHALVAN Scheme and Assistant Professor of Commerce and Dr. Karl Chinnu, the Placement Officer and Assistant Professor of Physics were also present. Ms. Smitha, SPOC and Assistant Professor of English thanked the dignitaries and the participants.



The Certificate course began on July 20, 2022 at 9.30am in C10 Hall with a few words of advice from Principal. The Guest Speaker of the day Dr. Surjeet Singh Kainth, Product Head, TimesPro oriented the students on the Basics of Logistics and Supply Chain Management.



Mr. Sabarivasan, the Trainer, kick started with the General Introduction. The topics that were introduced in the training sessions are Basics of Supply Chain Management and Logistics, Transportation Management, Basics of Warehousing, CFS, ICD, Goal Setting, Basic English Grammar, Time Management, Self-Introduction, Email Etiquette, Leadership, Resume, Interview Skills, Group Discussion etc. The activities based approach blended with the oral lectures and supplemented by powerpoint presentations drew the attention of the participants. Every day the students gave feedback on the sessions.



There were experts from Industry who gave talks both in virtual and face-to-face mode.

- The HR Team comprising of Mr. Nalin, Mr. Muthu Saravanan and Mr. Nitin interacted with the students and even conducted activities on August 25, 2022



- The Highlight of the training is the intra-collegiate event SKILL CHAMP held on August 27, 2022. It is a team-based intra-campus and inter-campus student engagement activity. The participants were divided into 15 teams with 5 member each.

EFFORTS COMMENCED IN 1971 WHEN THE GOVERNMENT OF TAMIL NADU LOCATED A HUGE LAKE LYING SOUTH OF MADRAS-CAICUTTA NATIONAL HIGHWAY AS THE SITE FOR THE PROPOSED COLLEGE. COMPANY PHILANTHROPY AND COMMON PEOPLE TOGETHER MOBILIZED THE GOVERNMENT STIPULATED SUM OF RS. 5 LAKHS (RUPEES FIVE LAKHS ONLY) AND THE FIRST BRICK WAS LAID ON CLAYEY SOIL ON 08/08/1972. THE THEN HON'BLE MINISTER FOR HARIJAN WELFARE PLAYED A NOTEWORTHY ROLE CONSISTENTLY. IT MUST BE RECORDED THAT THE SAME ASPIRATIONS OF THE PEOPLE, WHICH HELPED FOUND THE COLLEGE IN 1973, CONTINUE TO INSPIRE AND GUIDE THE TEACHERS AND SUPPORTING STAFF OF THE COLLEGE TO THIS DAY.

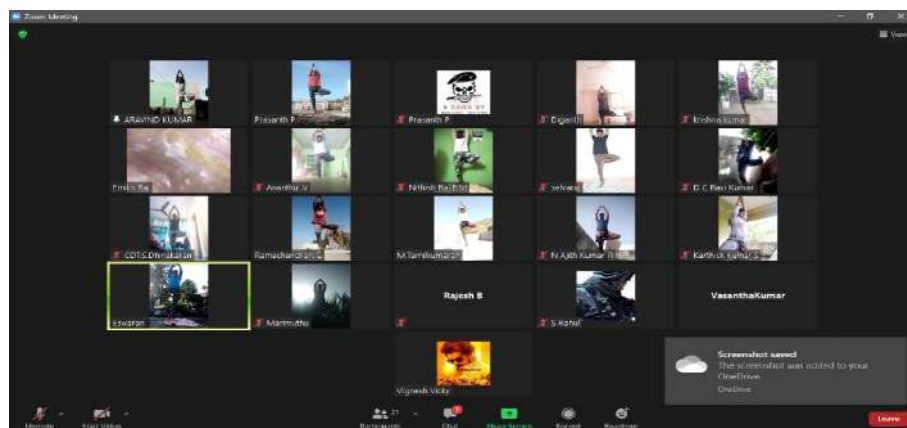

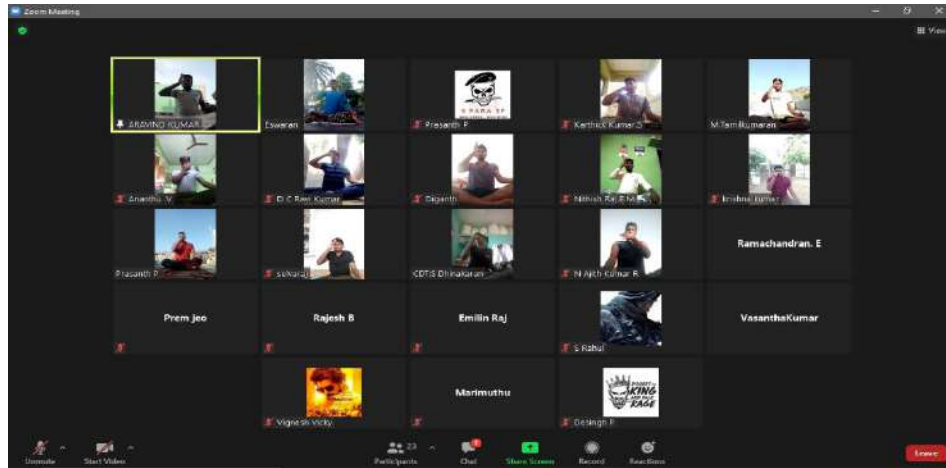

Yoga Day – Online





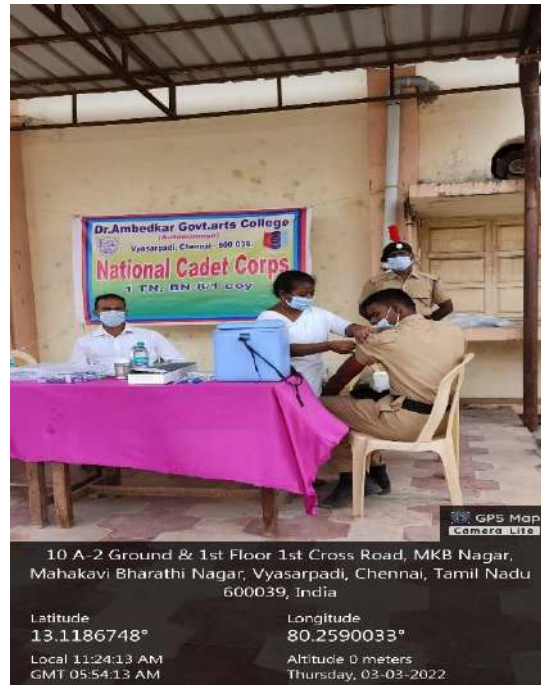
Yoga Day has been practised on 21.6.2021 through online mode. 104 cadets participated in the event.

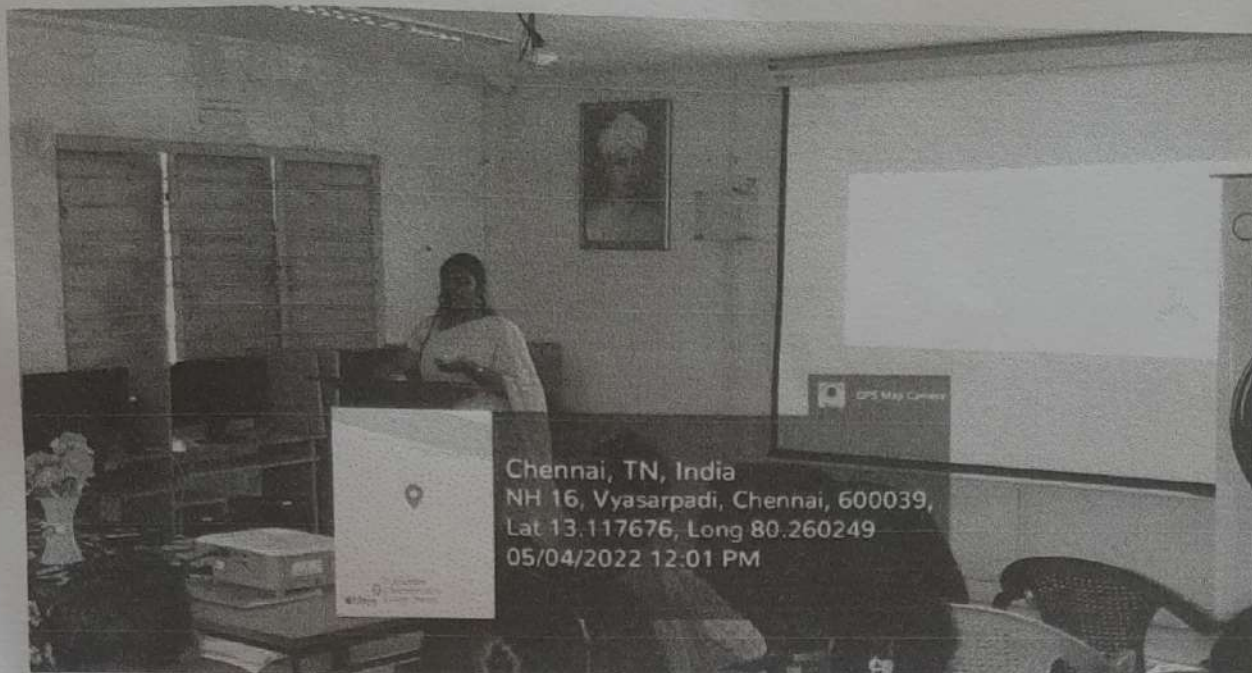
The Department of Social Work and Computer Science organized a seminar on “**Women and Decision Making - CRL**”.
