Registration for the workshop started at 9:15AM followed by the Inaugural session, Workshop Session , Open Discussion and Distribution of Certificates as per the schedule.

In all 100 participants attended the workshop, of these 70 participants only registered. 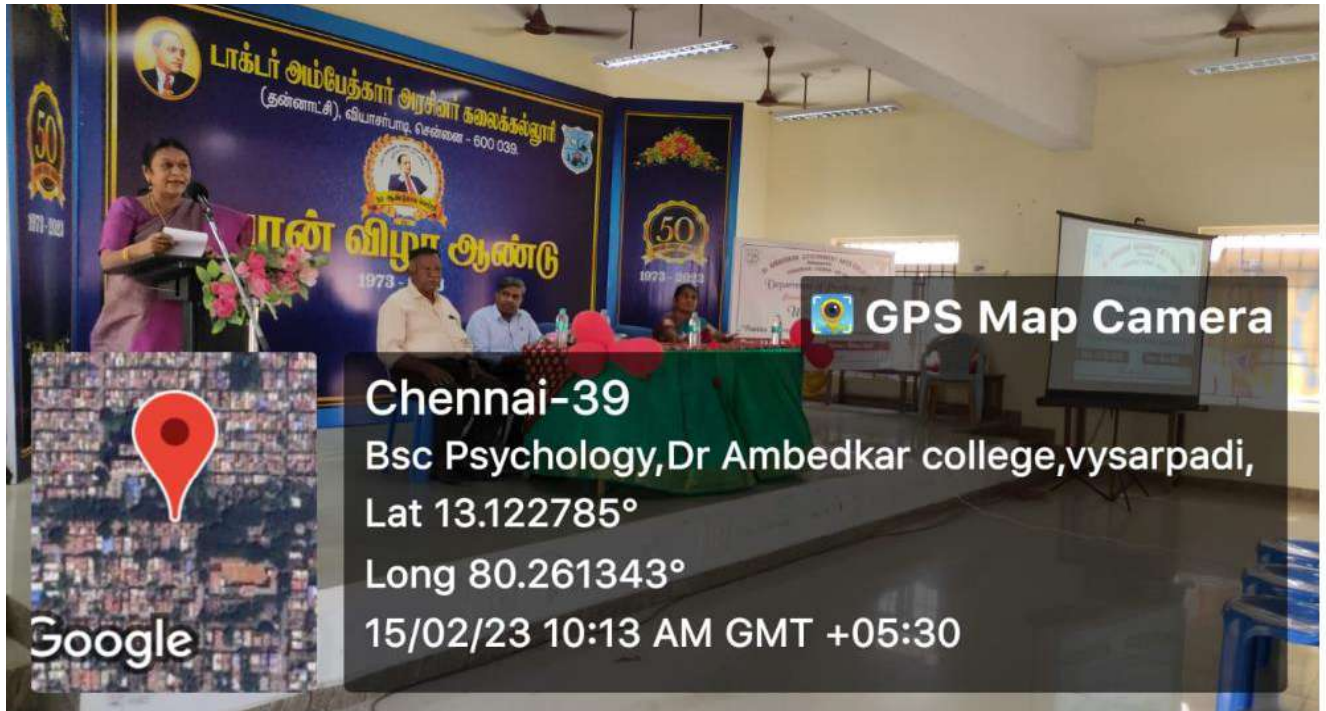
Open Discussion

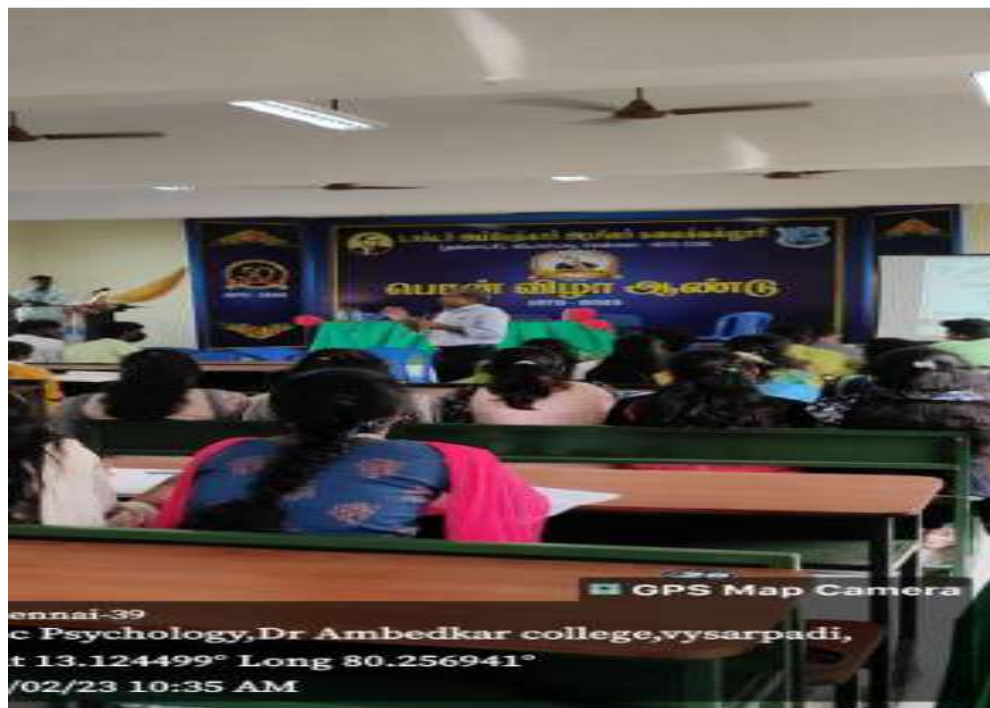
Valedictory
