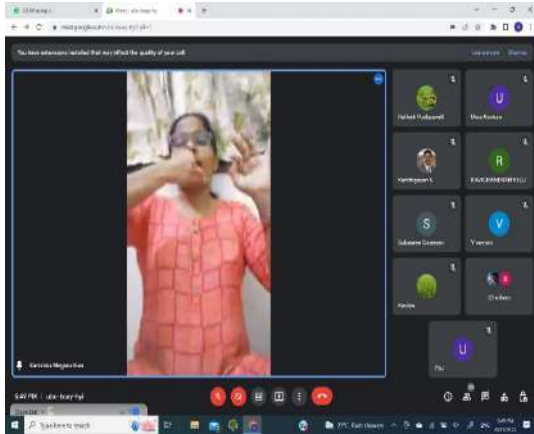
NSS Unit I & II

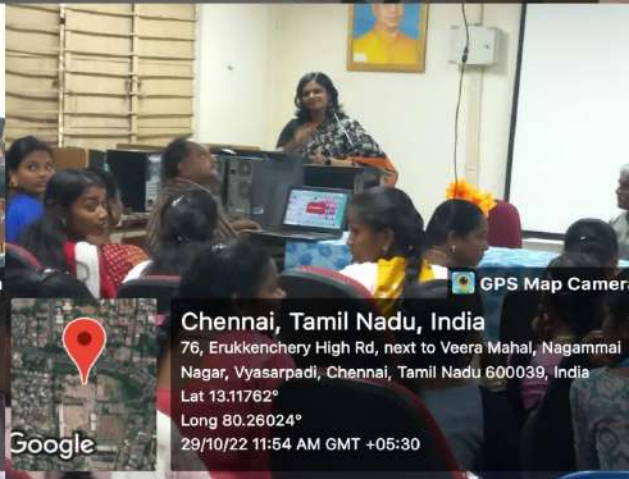
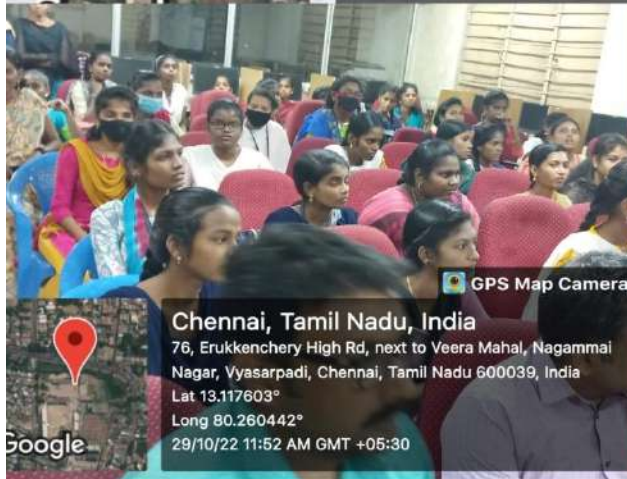

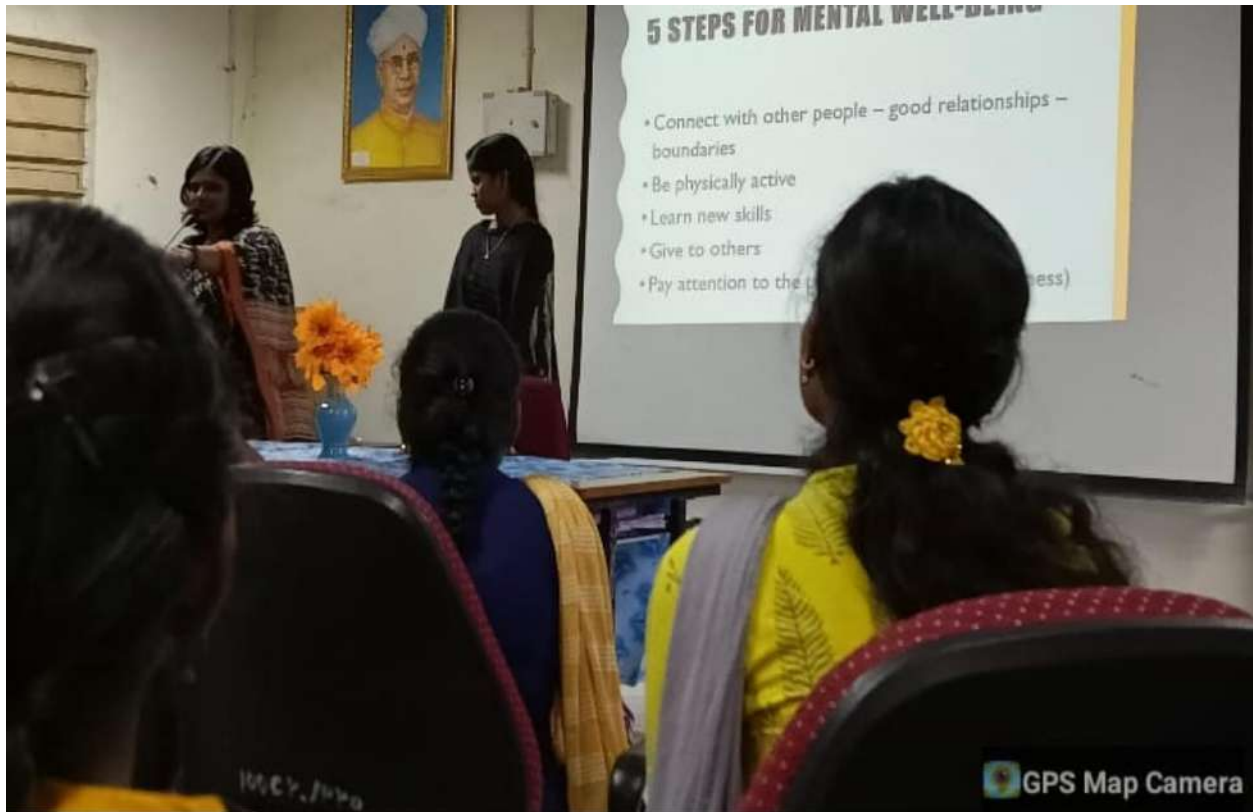

The Department of Social Work and Computer Science organized a seminar on **”MENTAL WELLNESS – BEING HOPEFUL”**.

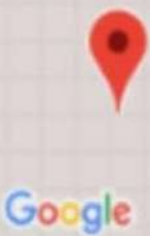
The seminar started by 11.30AM and Prof. D Krishnakumar welcome the chief guest, staff members and the students.

She had given 3minutes time to complete the game within the time limit only 1 team had completed the game, other 4 teams had quit the game by saying various reasons. The students shared their difficulties and experience to her, based on that she had compared the game with real time situation and also given a valuable advice to overcome from problems.(sometimes we have to quit problems like what the 4 teams had done or else whatever the situation we have to overcome it like winning team) Finally the speaker concluded her presentation by giving Child-line 1098, women 181 helpline numbers for solving women personal problems not only for our personal problem we can also call for other women harassment. Her session was so interesting and she also advised the students to build confidence and boldness in their daily life. 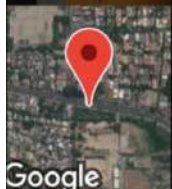

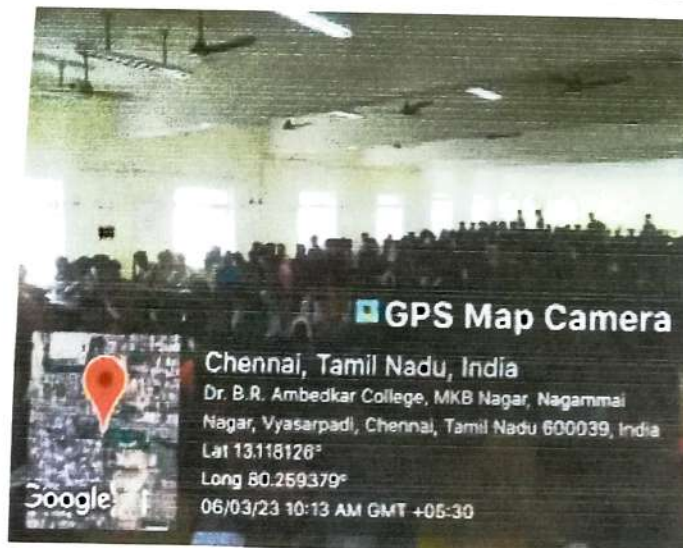

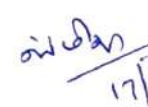

In commemoration of the Golden Jubilee Year Celebrations , 2023 the PG and Research Department of Zoology , organized a FREE HEALTH CAMP ON 03-03-2023 at the RUSA Auditorium in association with ACCUREX DIAGNOSTIC CENTRE, VYASARPADI AND SMILE AVENUE DENTAL CLINIC, MADHAVARAM. With an intention to provide access of medical health care and generate awareness towards health among the underprivileged sections of the society, one day medical health camp was organized. The programme specifically aimed at specializations as general medicine, , eye care and dental care for the community people. Technical support for this camp was provided by ACCUREX DIAGNOSTIC CENTRE,BOGAR VISION TRUST, VYASARPADI and SMILE AVENUE DENTAL CLINIC through a team of doctors and stock of medicines.

In the short span of around seven hours, 250 people women, men and college students could benefit from the health camp. Highest number of patients were related to aspects of general medicine. 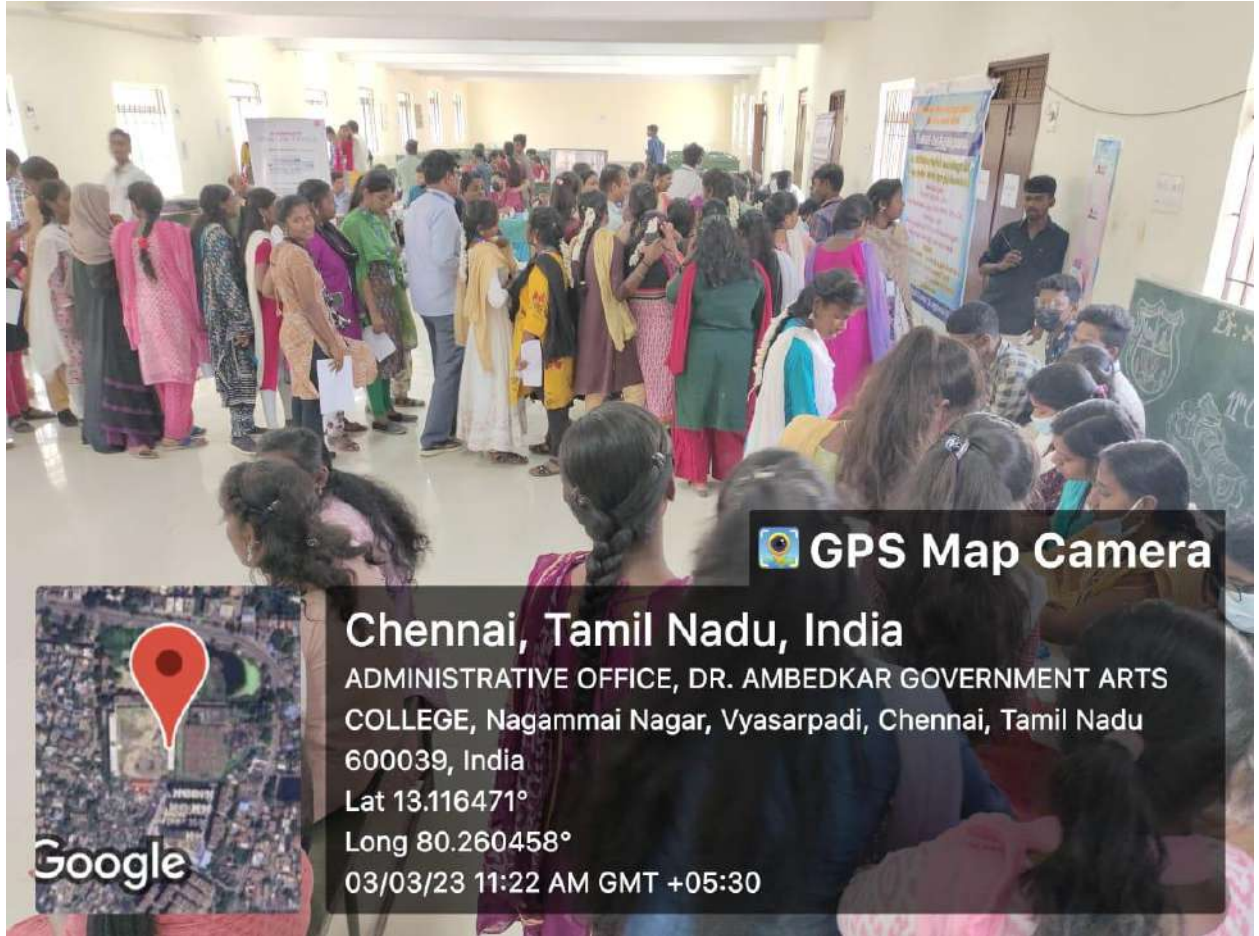

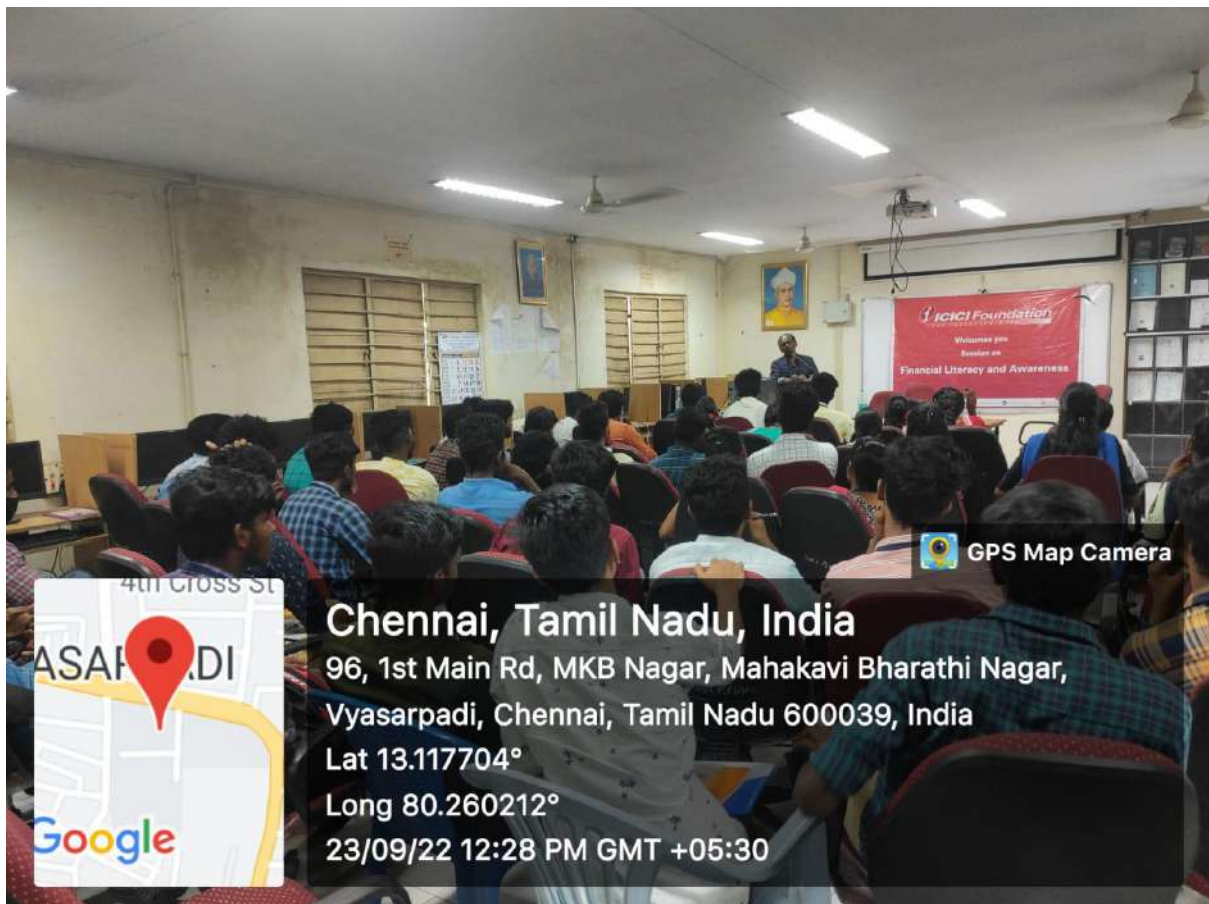

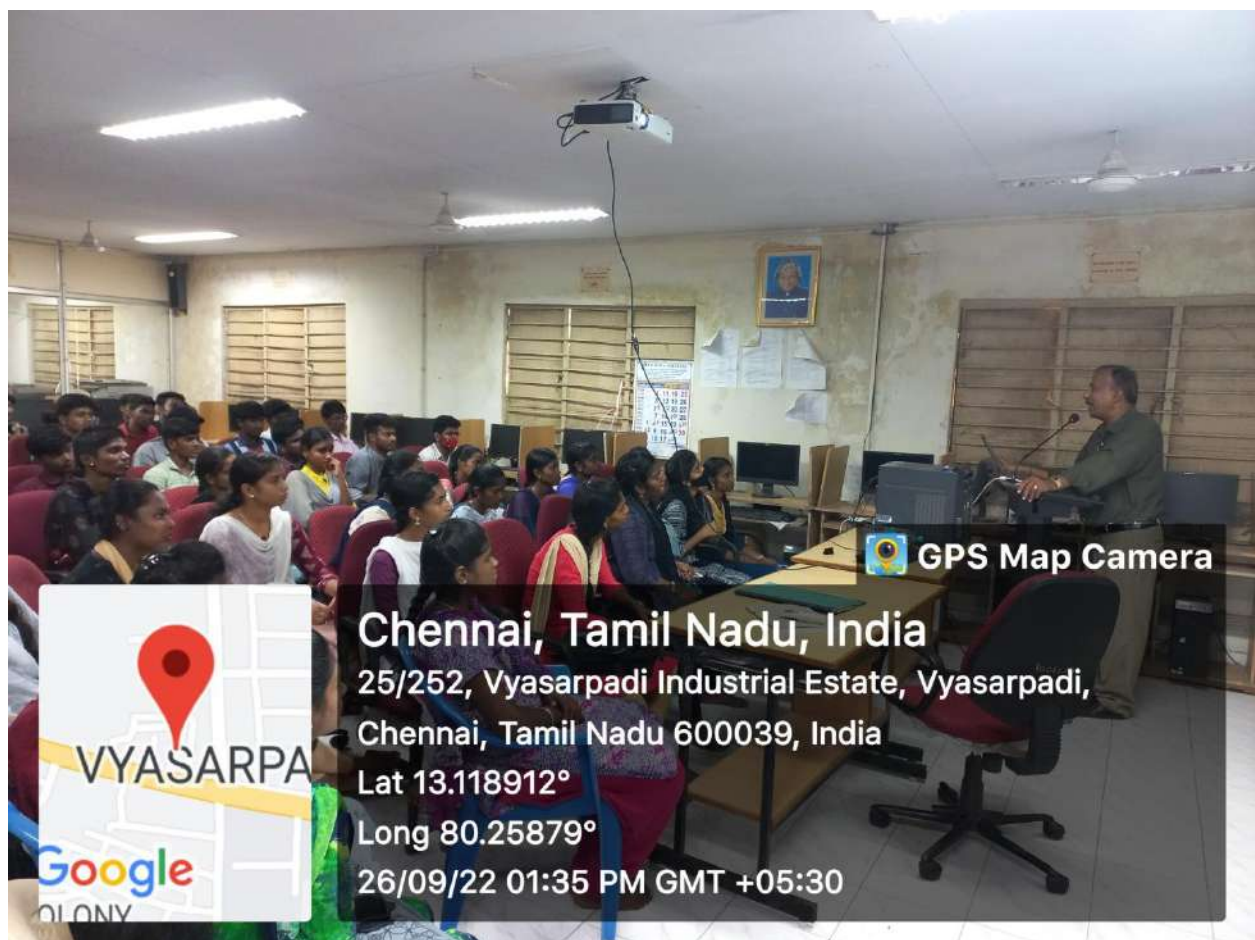
Objective:

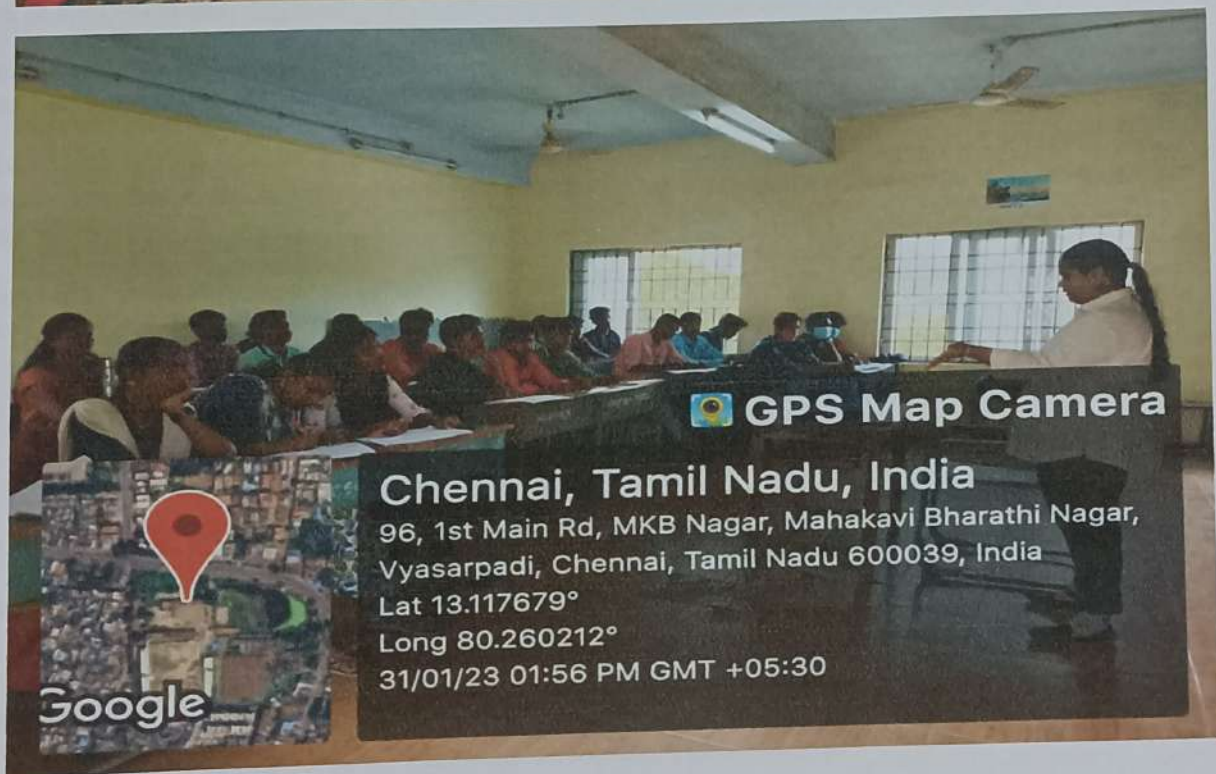
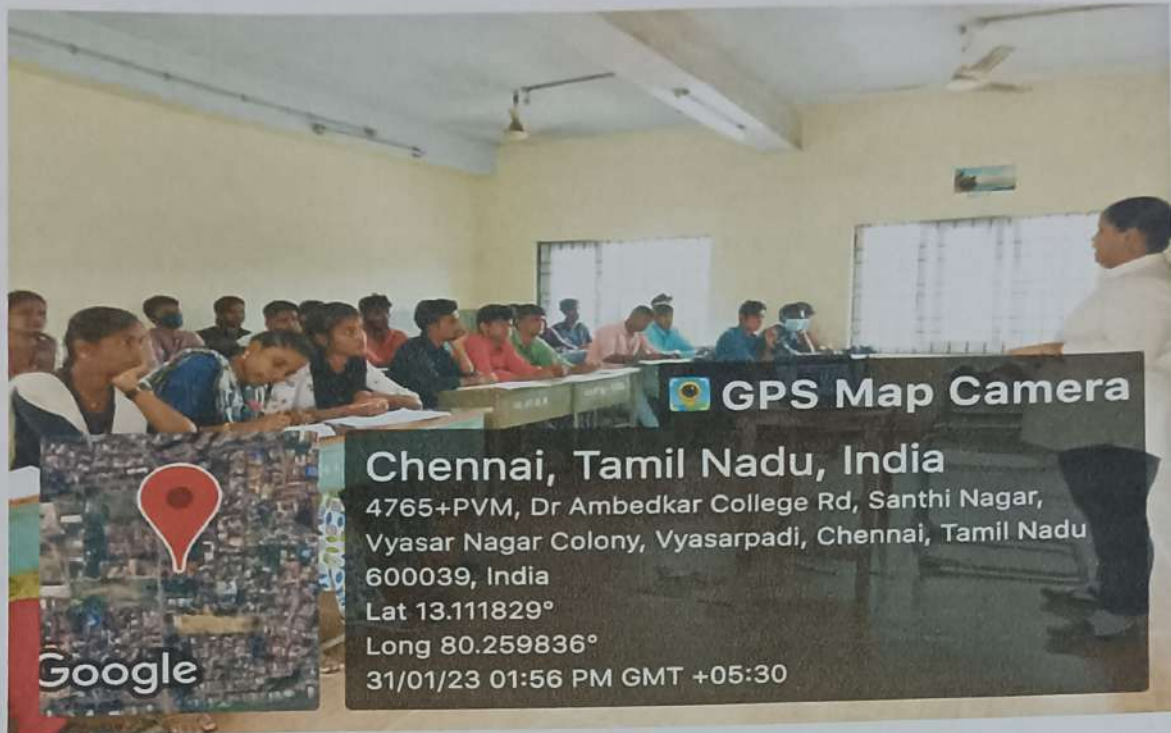
